BUILDING PERMITS

Building permits are required for new home construction, home repairs, remodeling, pond construction, pole barns, decks, etc. A building permit is required to promote and safeguard the public health, safety, and general welfare of the community. If you are unsure whether or not a permit is required, please contact our Building Inspector, Tom Westfall at 517-622-8078. Demolition permits are required for removal of structures.

Prior to applying for a permit for an outside addition or new construction, you must have approval from the Eaton-Barry Health Department, Environmental Health Unit. Their telephone number is 517-541-2615.

RECYCLING/COMPOST

Oneida Charter Township and the City of Grand Ledge cooperatively operate a recycling and composting center. The center is located in Grand Ledge on Whitney Street behind the Oakwood Cemetery.

The recycling and compost centers are open 3:00-7:00 p.m. on Wednesdays and 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. on Saturdays.

Recycle: Newspapers including inserts, magazines, and junk mail, plastic containers #1, #2, #3 and #7, clear and brown glass, corrugated cardboard, tin and aluminum cans, used cooking oil, Styrofoam, and household batteries can be dropped off at no charge to residents.

Compost: Leaves and brush.

Vehicles must have a compost window sticker at a cost of \$25.00. Stickers can be purchased at the Township or Grand Ledge City offices. If you purchase a sticker at the city, you must provide proof of residency e.g., tax or water bill.

TOWNSHIP CEMETERIES

Oneida Charter Township maintains three cemeteries.

- Union Cemetery- Benton Rd. 1/2 mile south of Eaton Hwy.
- <u>Pioneer Cemetery</u>- Hartel Rd. 1/2 mile south of Mt. Hope Hwy.
- <u>Strange Cemetery</u>- Oneida Rd. 1/4 mile south of Strange Hwy.

Residents may purchase a gravesite for \$200.00, nonresidents \$500.00. Please see our website for cemetery regulations.

EATON COUNTY SHERIFF
