7. Township Office Reports
  - a. Treasurer's Report was provided by Melissa Goschka and will be placed on file. She informed the Board that the annual audit is being conducted this week.

  - c. GLAESA report provided by Chief Roman. Chief Roman invited all to attend the Fire Department's open house this Saturday, March 14<sup>th</sup>, from 3-5pm.
